They take a picture of an object and record their own voice telling a story. Kids can draw a mouth on their object to make the object tell the story.</p>
 <p>My Story Book Creator School Edition \$4.99</p> <p>Kids can use drawing tools, graphics, photos, text, and audio to create a story. The story can be downloaded and/or shared online.</p>	 <p>Story Creator Free</p> <p>Kids can create stories using text, photos, videos and audio. This app also allows kids to leave comments on stories shared by friends.</p>
 <p>Tell About This \$3.99</p> <p>This app shows students images and prompts students to respond to the photos using audio and writing recordings.</p>	 <p>Shadow Puppet Edu Free</p> <p>Kids can use images, audio, music, maps, text, and drawing tools to create stories. Stories can be downloaded or shared online.</p>
 <p>Book Creator \$4.99 or online subscription</p> <p>Kids can create stories on an app or on an online platform. Teachers can set up book templates for students to fill in with audio, images, text, and drawing tools.</p>	 <p>Puppet Pals Free</p> <p>Kids can create an actor from a photo and select backdrops and other characters. Kids record their own audio to tell a story.</p>
